SUCCESSFUL INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS

Every innovation ecosystem reflects the culture, attitudes and social characteristics of its region. Knowledge is defenselessly dependent on its cultural superstructure. The examples chosen for this workshop are a colorful compilation of innovation ecosystems across the globe. Some regions seem similar until one digs a little deeper, then the differences become obvious.

The inputs and discussion will comprise insight and perspectives that allow participants to learn about the underlying foundations of each ecosystem and the hidden connections within and across ecosystems. The different angles of observation view will trigger participants' motivation to learn more about historical successes and failures in ecosystem evolution and about the possibilities for the future. The workshop contents will invite participants to let this mosaic of global innovation colors inspire individual choices in creating an open-minded painting that will allow leaders to understand each other better in the future.

MANAGEMENT OF RESOURCES

The management of resources considers all ingredients from an ecosystem perspective. Ecosystems try to promote their development as innovation leader in three key ways that is first analyzing the status quo, second deciding on a strategy and third implementing the chosen strategy. Most of the time, regions bite off more strategic objectives than they can chew, and implementation suffers. Many resource control knobs need to be turned simultaneously to be successful, so leaders have to set priorities and invest political energy in often unpopular areas.

The most important task is finding the balance between important ingredients like human capital, financial capital and infrastructure investments. To make the discussion independent from individual and institutional interests, the workshop focuses on two key dimensions of variation across resources: flexibility and importance. The energy to change the system or its dynamics is limited. Leaders can decide where to start and how much energy to invest in which resources based on the ecosystems' resource flexibility and importance.

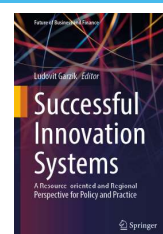
